Important people



Charlotte is a pedagogue that opens the SFO most mornings and works in classrooms during the day. She is from Lolland and loves working with children and enjoys the outdoors.

Charlotte and Trine will run the Spring School. Charlotte is the contact person.



Trine is a pedagogue that mostly works in classrooms during the day and helps the children in the afternoon SFO. Trine enjoys reading and streaming to her audience worldwide.

She is looking forward to meeting all the new students.



Mrs. Sandin is a teacher in Class A (Grade 0+1). Originally, from the United States, Mrs. Sandin will teach the subjects taught in English, such as English and mathematics. She will be one of the class-teachers from August.



Melissa is the other teacher in Class A. She moved from Canada to Denmark as a teenager and will teach the Danish language subjects, such as Danish, Religion, and Art.

You will visit her classroom most mornings to be a part of the morning routine with the current students in grade 0 and grade 1.

Before School SFO

Before school care is open from 6:30 am. Children are offered some breakfast through to 7:30. It is usually cereal (oats or cornflakes) or yoghurt. In morning SFO the children get to have some quiet 'hygge' time before school.



Morning routine

The children will start the day together with the current students from Class A. They will have their own space to keep a change of clothes and line up with the rest of the class. Here they will experience how the 'big kids' start the day and learn the morning routine at school.



Spring School Activities

The children will have plenty of time together following their own program. There are two spring school sessions each day, typically one will be in English while the other in Danish. Here the children will sing, count, dance, sort, draw, play and much more. This will start to get them ready for school after summer.



Move to Blæsenborg SFO

Children are accompanied by an adult to our friends at Blæsenborg. At first the children will take the bus but after a while they will walk the 20-25 minute walk like the rest of the students. The bus is always an option if the weather is bad.



Blæsenborg SFO

After they arrive at Blæsenborg they will eat lunch with the children from this school's early start program. Remember a healthy lunch box ☺

The afternoon is spent playing and exploring the larger playground. Guided by the pedagogues children are also offered a wide range of activities from role-play, arts and crafts, Lego, gaming and much more.

Children can be picked up from Blæsenborg throughout the afternoon through to 16:45.
